



LSO On Track CPD for Primary Teachers Continuing Professional Development Scheme 2013/14

Beginning in September 2013, the LSO On Track CPD Scheme is designed for teachers at KS2 who want to develop confidence and strategies for using music in the classroom. The Scheme is suitable for all KS2 teachers and other staff, whether you have no experience of using music in the classroom, some experience, or a great deal of experience.

The Scheme will be delivered by LSO Animateur Rachel Leach and specialists from the ten borough Music Services of East London*, supported by LSO Players, and focuses on a creative approach to music-making. Delivery will take place mainly in 3 borough centres in East London (locations TBC).

Benefits

- Skills and activities immediately transferrable to the classroom from the beginning of the Scheme
- Free tickets for one class to attend an LSO Schools Concert at the Barbican
- LSO Animateur and Player visits to your school, with the final visit including a performance to a group of your school's Key Stage One

Time Commitment

- Three term course (Autumn 2013, Spring 2014, Summer 2014)
- Ten mid-week twilight sessions (c4.30-6.30pm) per term in a borough near you (Borough Centres to be announced in Summer 2013)
- One 'Creative Day' per term for all teachers on the course at the Barbican or LSO St Luke's including two free tickets per teacher to the associated LSO evening concert
- Classroom time to try out new ideas and strategies with your class
- 3 short written tasks to complete per term to consolidate learning and develop reflective practice

Cost (NB: details not confirmed)

- Cost of £450 per teacher for the course
- £90 (c50%) contribution from the LSO toward supply cover for each Creative Day

Accreditation

The LSO On Track CPD Scheme offers a progression route to take a Trinity College Licentiate Diploma following completion of the course, for which the LSO will cover entry fees and make support from Music Service specialists available. CPD Scheme written work is partly based on written work required for the qualification. A fee may be payable for teachers wishing to be entered for accreditation.

NB: Trinity stipulate candidates must have minimum Trinity Gd 6 or equivalent on an instrument or voice

- Application forms will be made available in the first half of the Summer Term 2013
- Places are very limited and you are very strongly advised to attend an LSO On Track CPD Scheme Taster Session or Creative Day before applying for the Scheme
